<u>Please Note:</u> We encourage all applicants to apply for a scholarship. Students must pay the 15% enrollment fee of their tuition before the commencement of their program of study. If you are a recipient of a scholarship, it will be applied to your total tuition, before you pay the enrollment fee. The scholarship funds are released to mirror what the student has paid or pays if on a Flexible Payment Plan. For example, if a student pays their 15% enrollment fee upon admission, then the equivalent amount will be released from their scholarship and applied to their account. If the student drops out of the school, then any remaining scholarship will be null and void, and the student will be responsible for any outstanding fees pro-rated to match courses taken.
